“Sledgehammer or Scalpel? Terror Financing Laws and the Constitution”

Professor Cole will discuss the civil liberties issues presented by the current US and international regime for restricting terror financing, including issues considered by the Supreme Court in *Holder v. Humanitarian Law Project* (Professor Cole will be presenting oral arguments in this case). This current case challenges the constitutionality of such laws as applied to speech and association, and issues of due process related to the designation of organizations and the freezing of their assets, which are currently being considered in the lower courts in the US and by domestic and international courts in Europe.
